Hi Frank,

Thank you for the approval.

The Syniti tooling is only for data migration, and purchased on a subscription contract whose end date is aligned to the end of the SyWay program (i.e. 4 years, ending 31/3/2029). If the just-launched RFP for master data governance tooling were to select Syniti, it would anyways be a different product which would not be covered by this Application Architecture Design document.

I'll set up a separate call in January with Owen, Laurent, and me to discuss how the ICertis integration is designed and built.

As discussed overall I would like to have a session that runs us through different scenarios we may need to cater for, and how those will be catered for.
