

Get an "Awesome table" embed code from a Google site

Overview

An "Awesome table" is way to display a Google spreadsheet with advanced functionalities on Google Site pages. This section describes the procedure to embed it into a page in Solvay ONE.

Pre-requisite: the "Awesome table" to embed must be used in a Google site. If needed, you could follow the [Awesome table dedicated documentation](#) .



Advanced level

This operation requires to browse some code to identify a specific part to copy-paste.

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Step-by-step guide

Step 1: on Google site side: Get the Awesome table code

1. Reach the Google site page containing the Awesome table

2. Press "F12", then "Select an element to inspect".

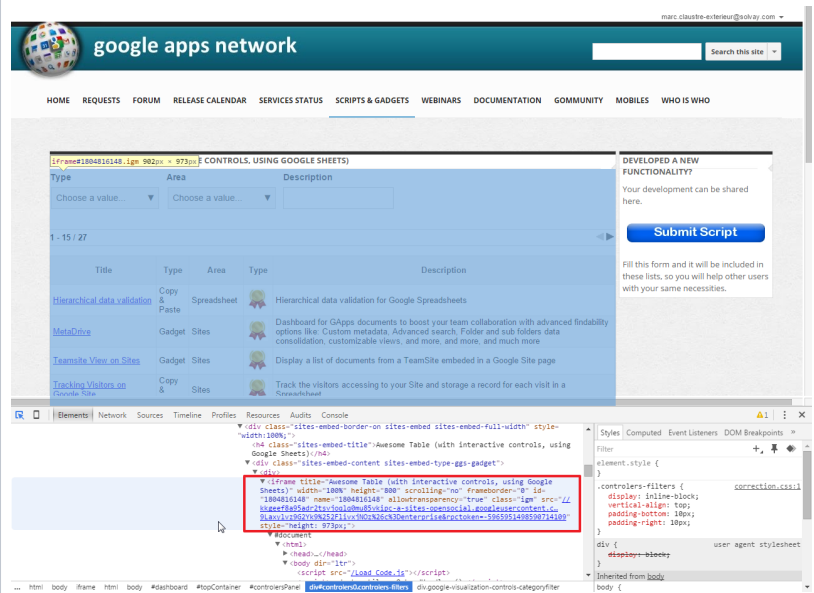
3. Click on the first filter of the Awsome table.

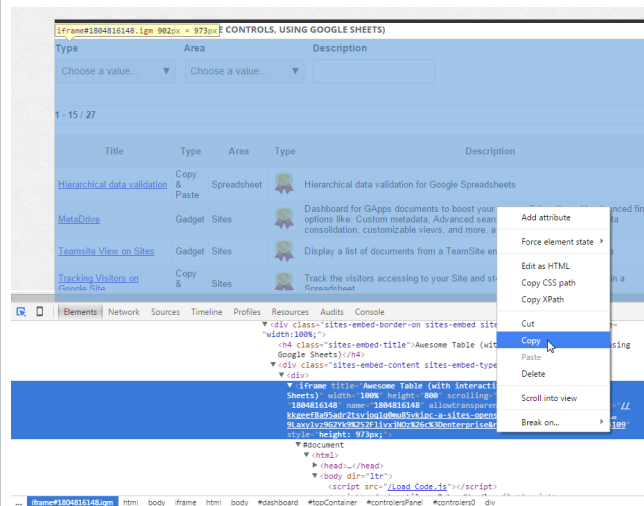
4. Scroll-up the bottom pane to display the <iframe ... par of code.
