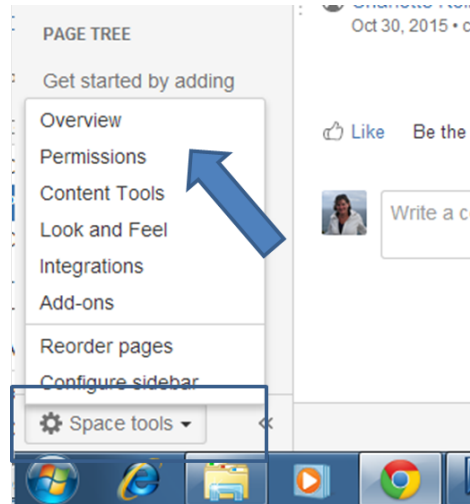

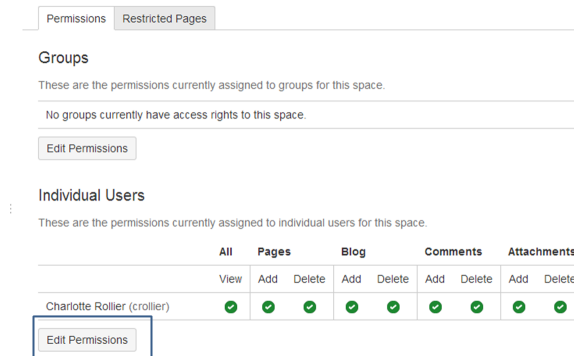
STEP 1

[Edit Permissions](#)

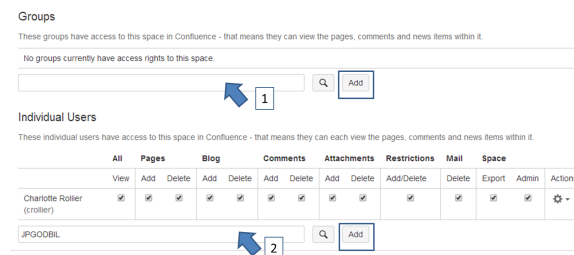
STEP 3

2. or an individual user

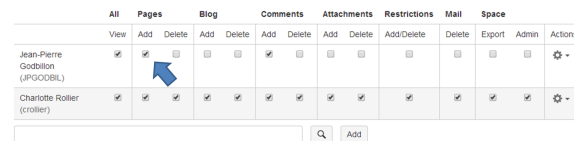
