

KSV4 - Delete Actual Distribution Cycle

STEP 1



The only situation where you would delete a cycle is if it was created in error and never used.

In case the cycle has run, the better way to proceed is to close cycle for the following period by modifying the ending date of the cycle.

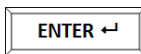
