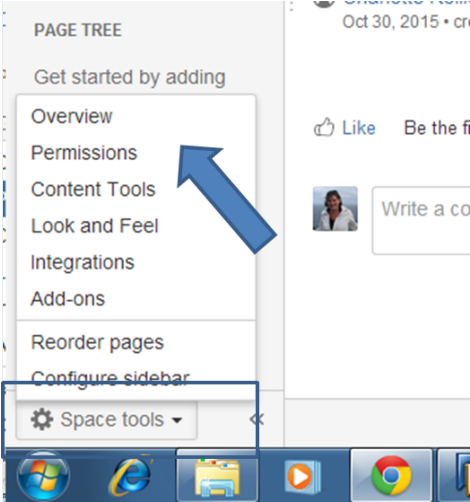


Manage permissions in Confluence

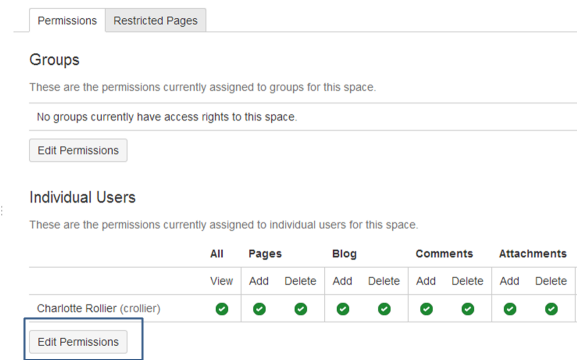
STEP 1

STEP 2

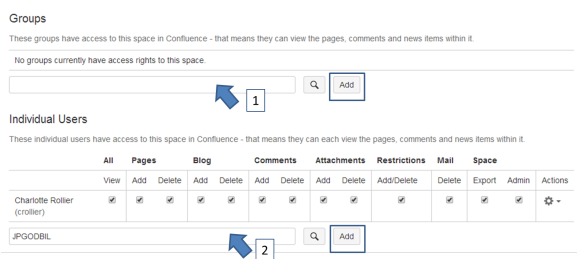
Click on "Edit Permissions"



STEP 3

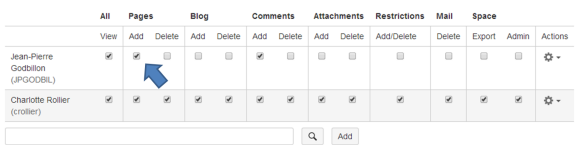
- Enter:
