How to get SAP Access?

Step-by-step guide

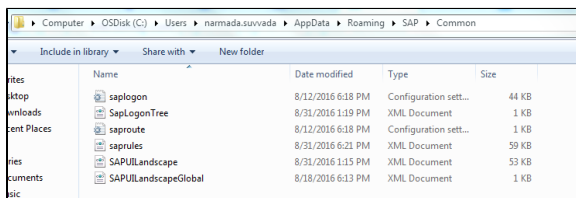
There are two steps to be followed to get SAP Access.

STEP 1 : First Download all the 6 Notepad's specified in the Link's below (Click on the link & save them in specified path)

1. [saplogon.ini](#)
2. [saproute.ini](#)
3. [SapLogonTree.xml](#)
4. [saprules.xml](#)
5. [SAPUILandscape.xml](#)
6. [SAPUILandscapeGlobal.xml](#)

STEP 2 : Now all the file's(Downloaded file's) has to be imported into the path shown below :

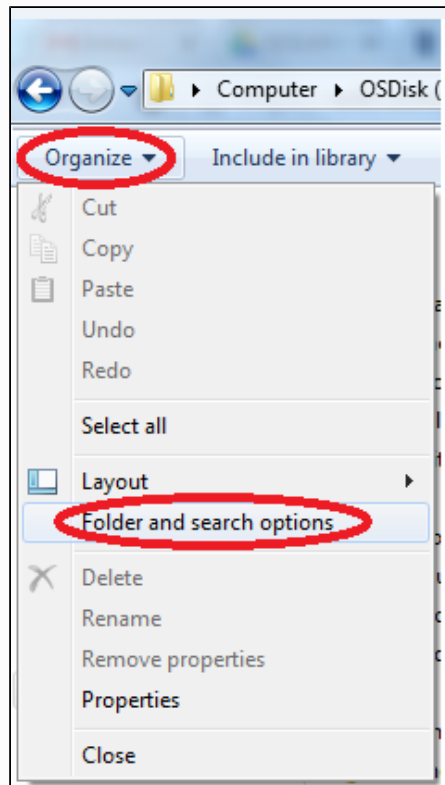
Goto [Start](#) -> [Computer](#) -> [C:\Users\<username>\AppData\Roaming\SAP\Common](#)



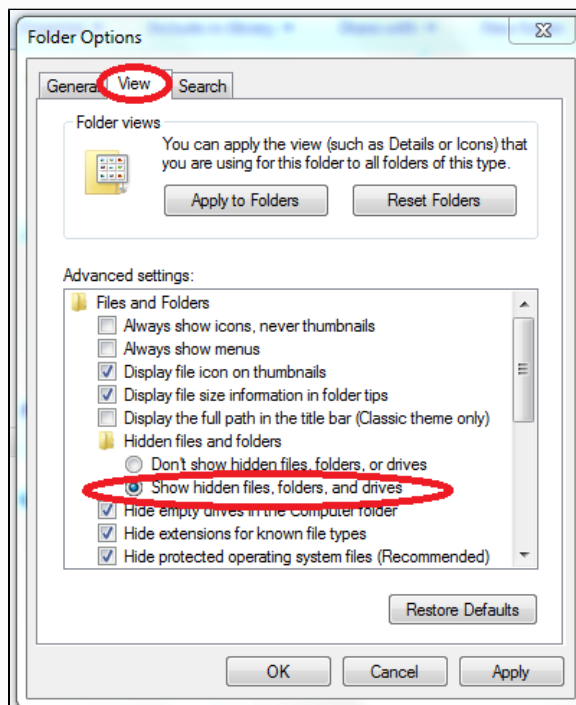

- If you are unable to find [AppData](#) in the specified path(Under [<username>](#)), just make the following settings there :

Goto Organize -> Folder & search Options, then you can see the screen shot shown below

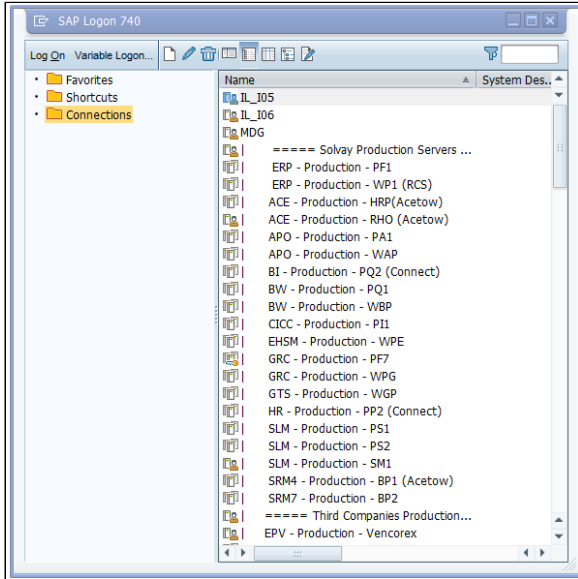


Now switch to **VIEW** tab & select "Show hidden files" radiobutton. So that you can see the hidden items.



So, that you can see [AppData](#) folder in the path!.

Once you have imported the file's, Just launch the Logon test to confirm and below screen shot should appear.
