Salesforce navigation is very smooth once you understand the basic rules. All pages are structured the same way and uses the same principles.

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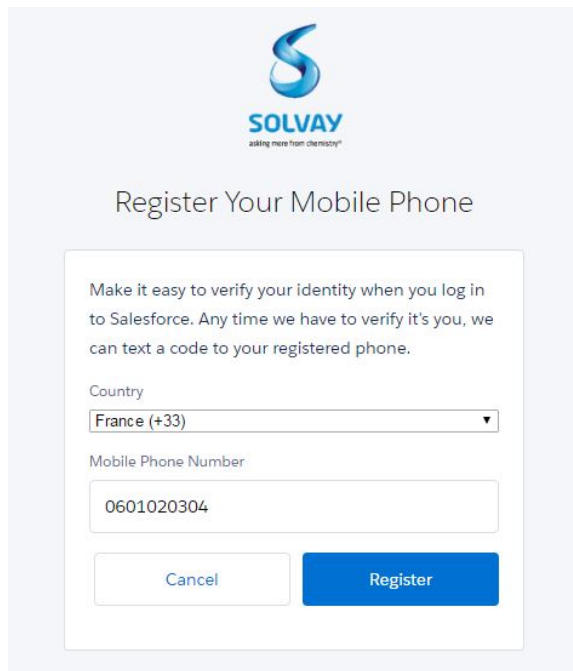
How to log into Salesforce ?

Convergence uses Single Sign On : no need for login and password. Just type the following URL in Google Chrome :

<https://solvaysrm.my.salesforce.com>

If you connect for the first time, you will have to register your phone number.

Otherwise you can use the "I don't want to register my phone".
