Drupal is content management software. It's used to make many of the websites and applications you use every day. Drupal has great standard features, like easy content authoring, reliable performance, and excellent security. But what sets it apart is its flexibility; modularity is one of its core principles. Its tools help you build the versatile, structured content that dynamic web experiences need.

**Q:** What is Drupal?


**A:** Drupal is a new tool that will replace Tridion for all Solvay Internet websites.

This tool works as a content management system in which we can create/delete/modify all of the website's content.

All of the content on a Drupal website is stored and treated as "nodes".

A node is any piece of individual content, such as a page, press release, article, location or a contact entry.

As a solvay.com contributor, you will have access to 2 environments:

Test environment:	Production environment:
