

South Korea's Tongsuh to restart No 3 ACN line in mid-Jan

South Korea's Tongsuh Petrochemical is expected to restart its 245,000 tonne/year No 3 acrylonitrile (ACN) line in Ulsan in mid-January, a company source said on Friday.

The plant was shut down around 26 December, according to the source. "We are going to restart the plant around 14 January," the source said.

The company's 70,000 tonne/year No 2 ACN line in Ulsan is running at 100% and its 245,000 tonne/year No 4 line, also in Ulsan, is running at 80-85%, according to the source.
