




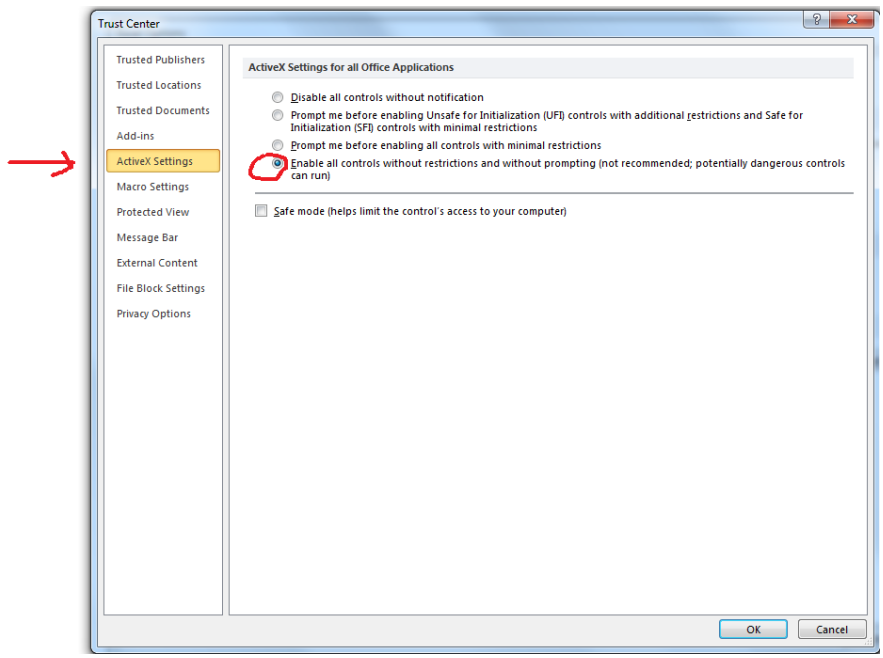
How to enable macro using automatic reports in Excel

If you're encountering issues when generating the **Accolade automatic reports**, it may be caused by your EXCEL parameters that are too restrictive.

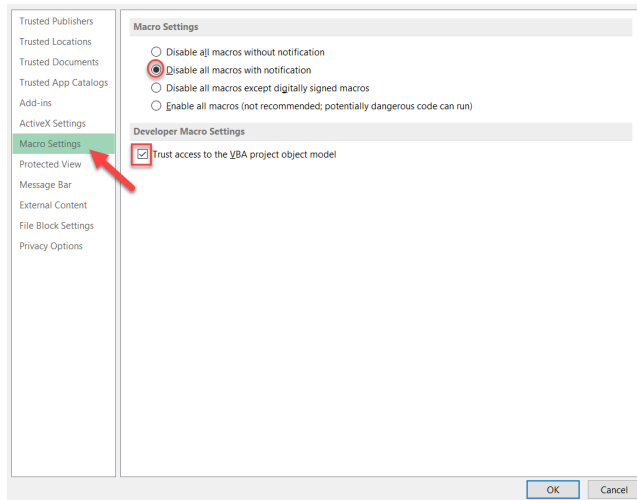
Please, follow the procedure to "**Enable Editing**":

Step to reproduce	Screen Capture
1 / Open an brand new EXCEL file	
2 / File > Options	
3 / Open the Trust Center , then the Trust Center Settings	

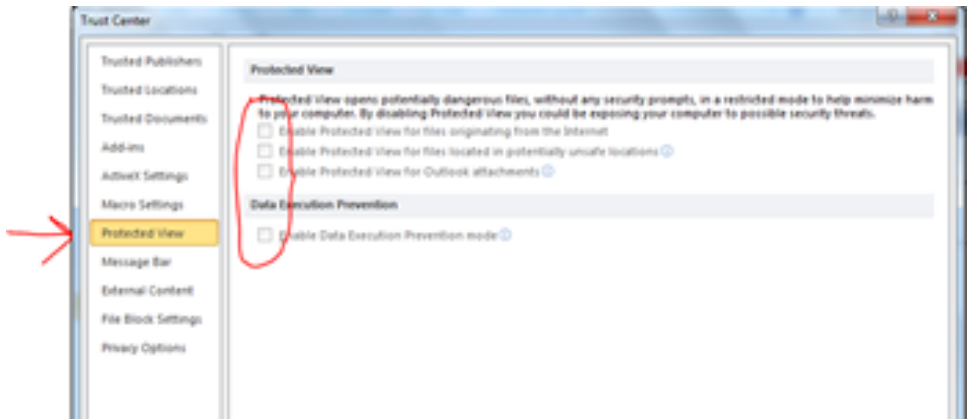
4 / Go to **ActiveX Settings** in the left menu and **Enable all control** and remove the Safe Mode



5 / Go to **Macro Settings** in the left menu and **Enable all macros** and **Trust access to the VBA project object model**



6 / Go to **Protected View** and untick all the boxes



7 / Click **OK** twice and close EXCEL
