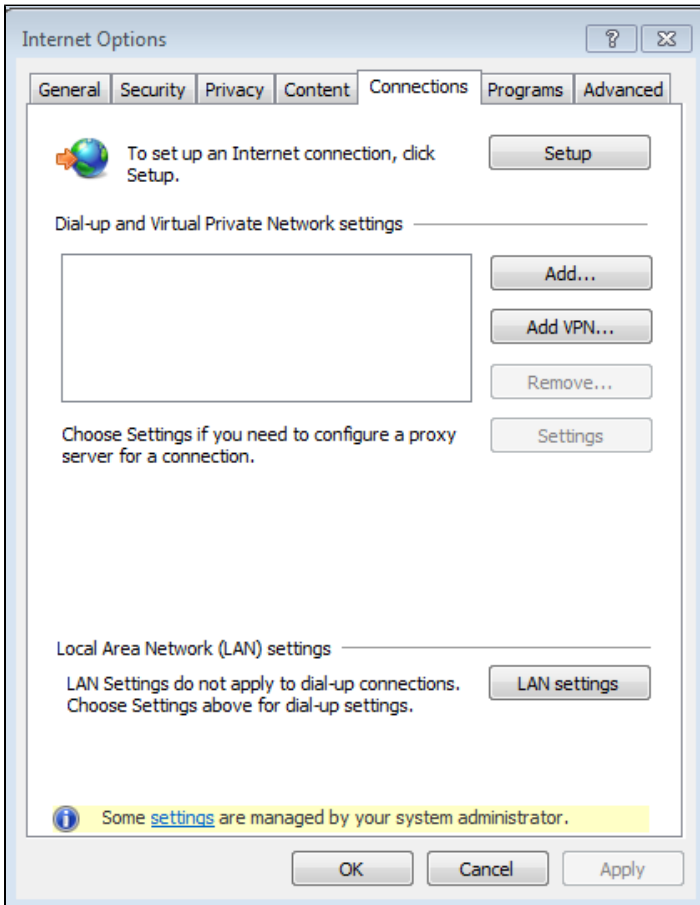
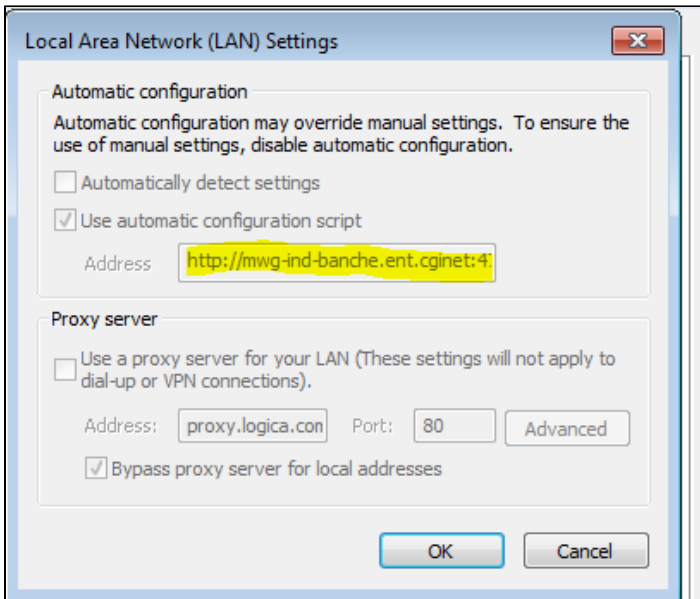


Procedure for VDI connection

- **Step 1:** Goto Tools -> Internet Option -> Connections ->LAN Settings



- **Step 2:** Make a note of your Address



- **Step 3:** Go to Run and type cmd click enter
