

BASF Antwerp acrylic acid plant running following technical problems

Germany-headquartered chemicals major BASF's Antwerp acrylic acid (AA) facility is now back up and running, sources said this week.

This was said to be following technical problems that began at the facility at the end of September during a planned turnaround, sources have said. There was no direct confirmation from BASF.

BASF has the capacity to produce 320,000 tonnes/year of acrylic acid at the Antwerp facility.
