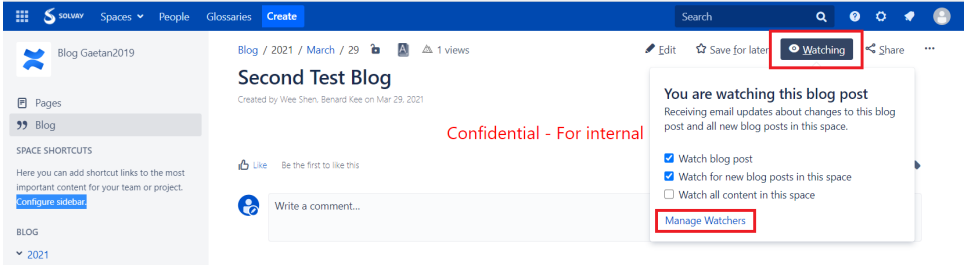
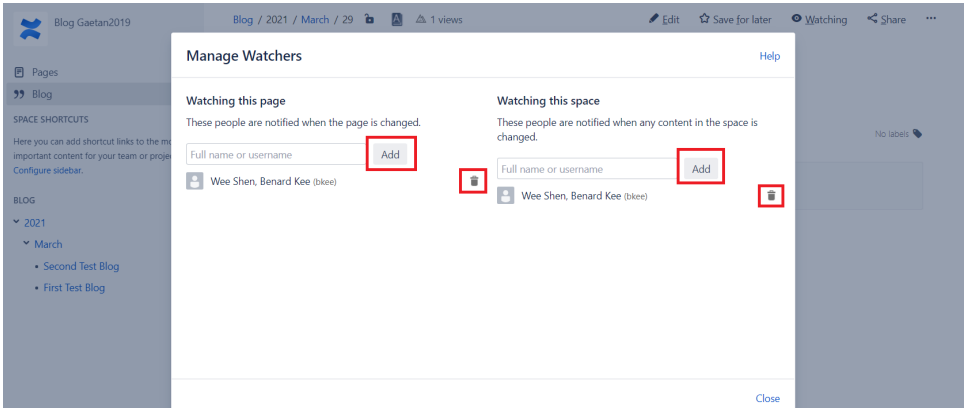


How to manage page / blog post watchers list
