Drupal lets to add content as an IFrame like Keepeek Slideshows, Google Maps etc

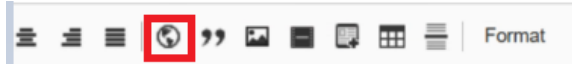

## Step-By-Step

### STEP 1

Click on IFrame icon(Globe symbol)



### STEP 2

We have to define different properties :

- Source-URL
- Width or height of iframe, allowed: numbers (in px, without "px") btw. percents (e. g. "70%")
- Title, optionally
- Attributes for "frameborder" and "scrolling" (selects)

**Long Description URL**

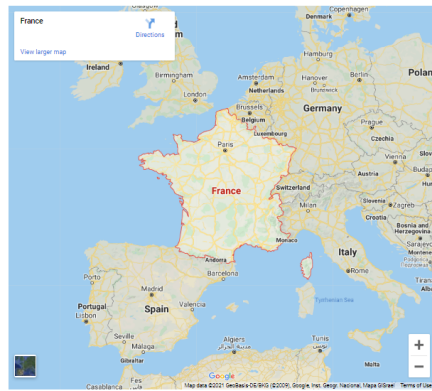
