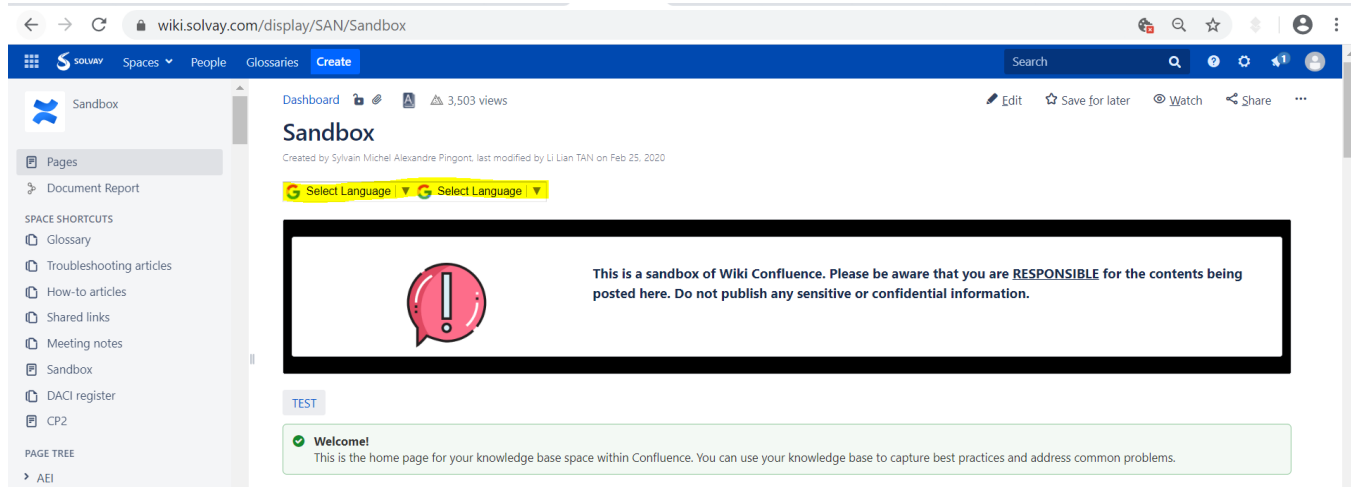


Google Translate issue

Due to some bugs Google Translate option appears twice in some Confluence space.

Example



In order to make it corrected to have a single translation option as a normal behavior please follow the below steps

Step 1: Go to Space ToolsLook & Feel option

Step 2: Under Layout option, choose Page Layout and click on Edit

Site Layouts

Site layouts are used to draw the controls that surround each page in the site. If you wish to change the appearance of the site: for example changing the headers or footers, moving the menus or custom links, you will want to modify these layouts.

Decorator	Operations
Main Layout Defines the generic header and footer for all pages in Confluence.	< default > · Create custom · View default
Global Layout Defines the appearance of the dashboard and a user's profile.	< default > · Create custom · View default
Popup Layout Popup windows such as the user history popup are displayed using this layout.	< default > · Create custom · View default
Printable Layout The layout used to display the page when the user clicks the "printable" icon in the top-right of the page.	< default > · Create custom · View default

Content Layouts

Content layouts control the appearance of content such as pages and news posts: they don't change the way the pages themselves are displayed, but they allow you to alter the way the surround comments or attachments are shown.

Decorator	Operations
Space Layout Controls how a space is displayed.	< default > · Create custom · View default
Page Layout Controls how a page is displayed.	Edit · Reset default · View default
News Post Layout Controls how a news post is displayed.	< default > · Create custom · View default
Classic Comments Layout Controls how comments on pages and news posts are displayed in the Classic theme.	< default > · Create custom · View default

Step 3: There is ID called google_translate element which is called in CSS class here.

Usually we should have only one google translate element, but here we can see we have two elements
