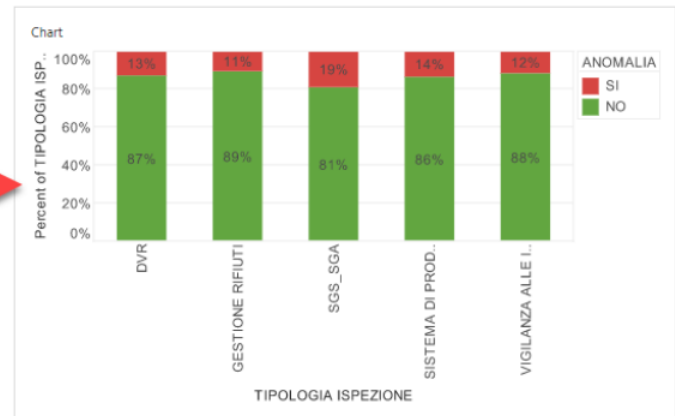
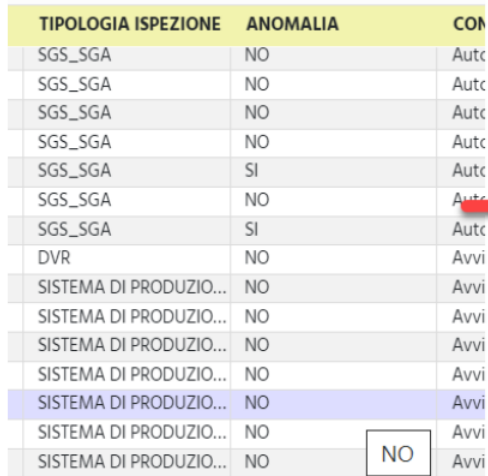


Create a 100% stacked column chart

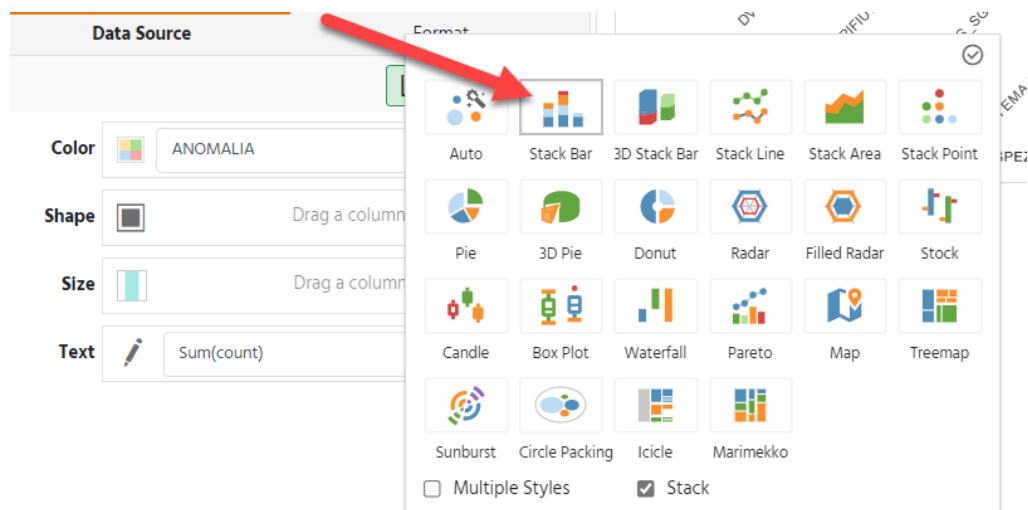
This article explains how to create a 100% stacked column chart, which is a standard chart type in Data Studio.



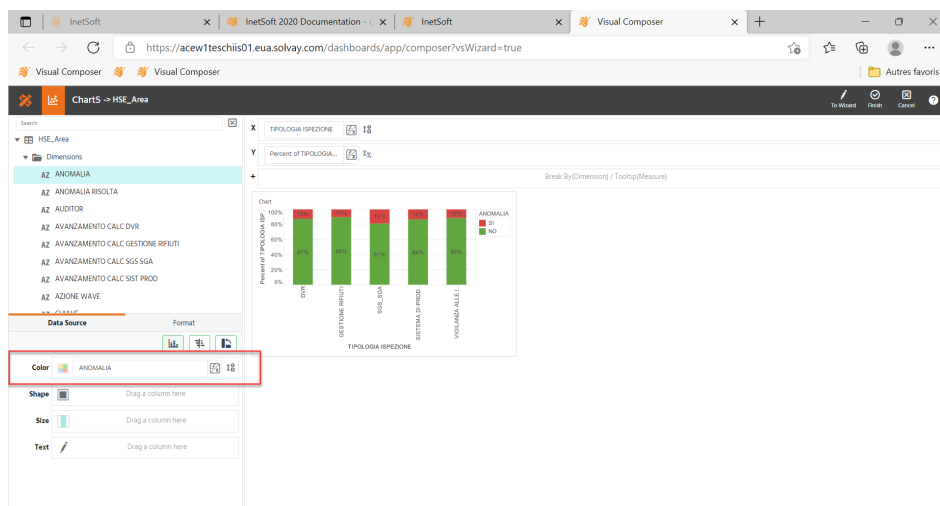
In our case we want to plot on the x-axis the inspections types and on the y-axis a stacked column bar counting how many anomalies were found per each type of inspection.

Step-by-step guide

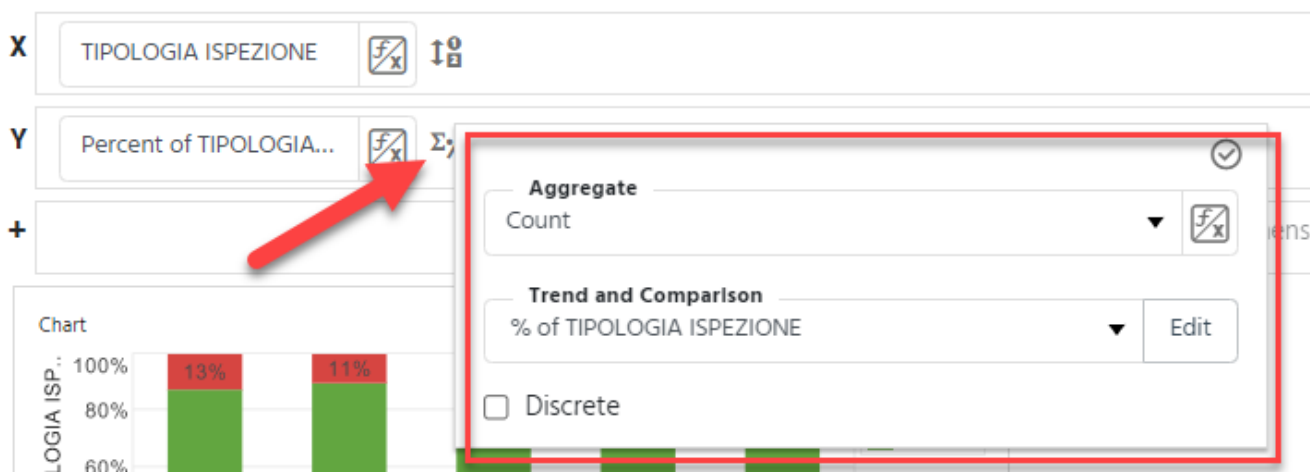
- Create a stacked column bar chart



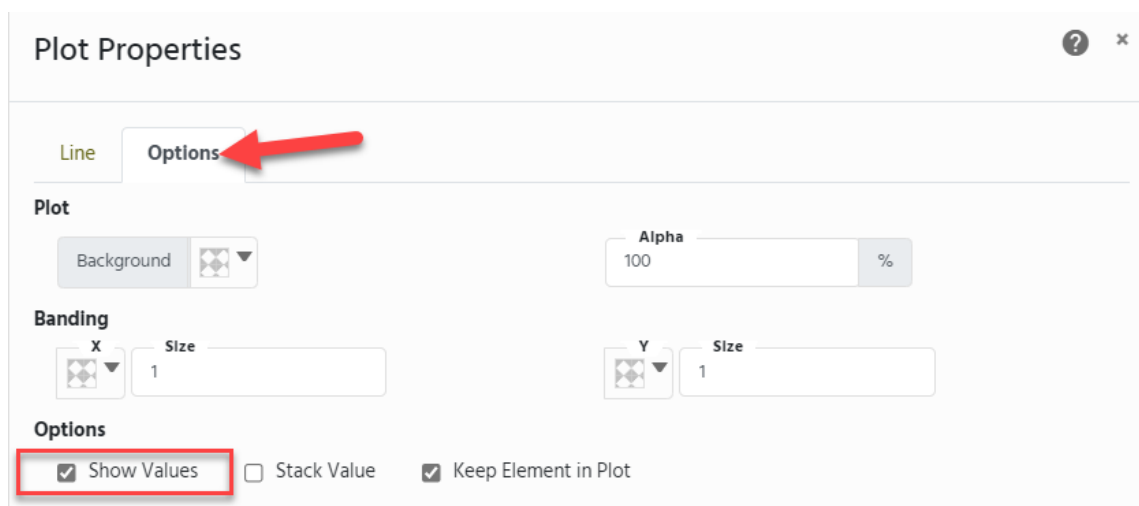
- Select the desired x and y axis dimensions and color the bars by the *Anomalia* column (the dimension you wish to stack)



- In order to have a stacked 100% chart change the aggregation type to *count* and set the *trend and comparison* field to *% of your x-axis*



- In order to display the values inside the bar, right-click on the chart area and select *Plot properties*. Go to the *Options* tab and check the *Show values* option
