

Rotational Rheometers

Principle

Application of a shear rate range (in steady mode) or a strain frequency (in dynamic mode) and measurement of the correspondent resistance of the material to flow to determine viscosity and viscoelastic properties (η , G' , G'' and $\tan$) respectively.

Capabilities

- Measurement of viscosity in a wide range of shear rates (0.01 - 1000 s⁻¹) and temperatures.
- Frequency sweep tests for viscoelastic materials.
- Time sweep test to evaluate stability.
- Temperature sweep test for screening crosslinking temperature, gelation point, ...
- Dynamic Mechanical Analyses (DMA) for phase transitions and modulus variation with temperature.
