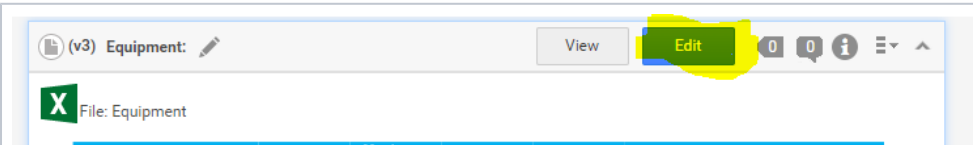
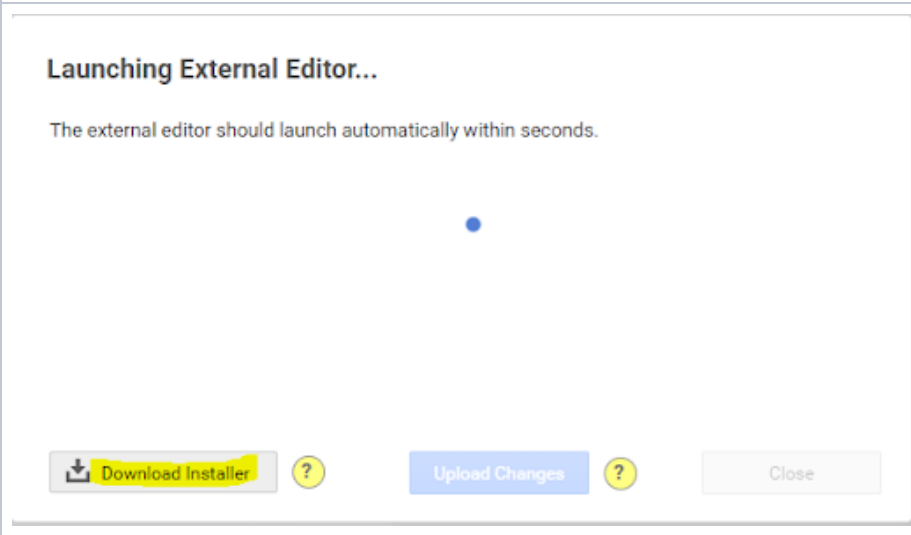


How to Install the IDBS External Editor

IDBS External Editor Integration is a small component allowing you to directly edit a Microsoft Office document in an experiment (removing the need to download & upload the file at every update !

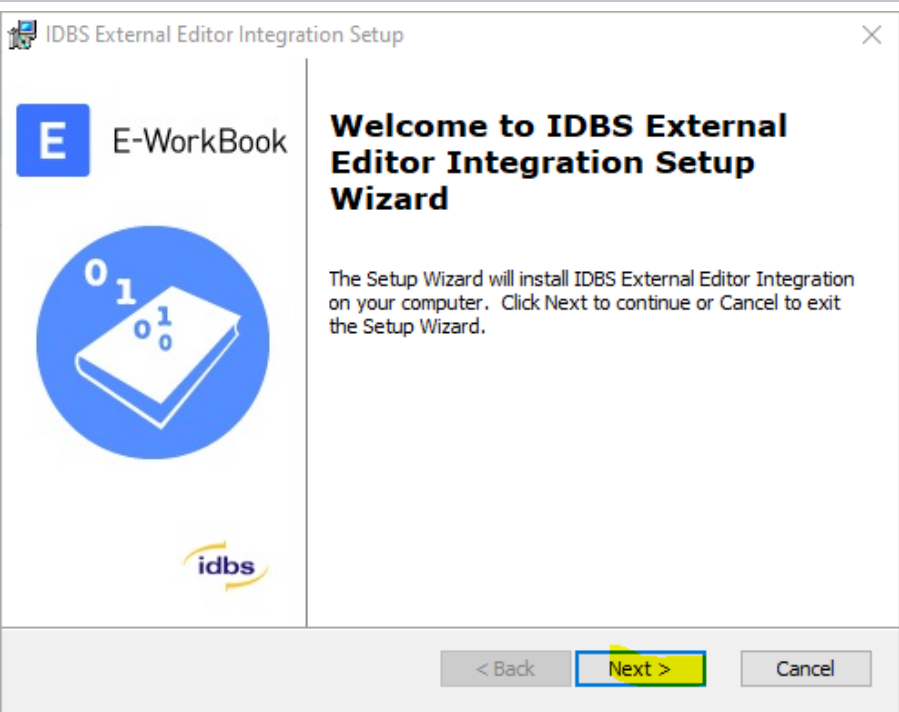
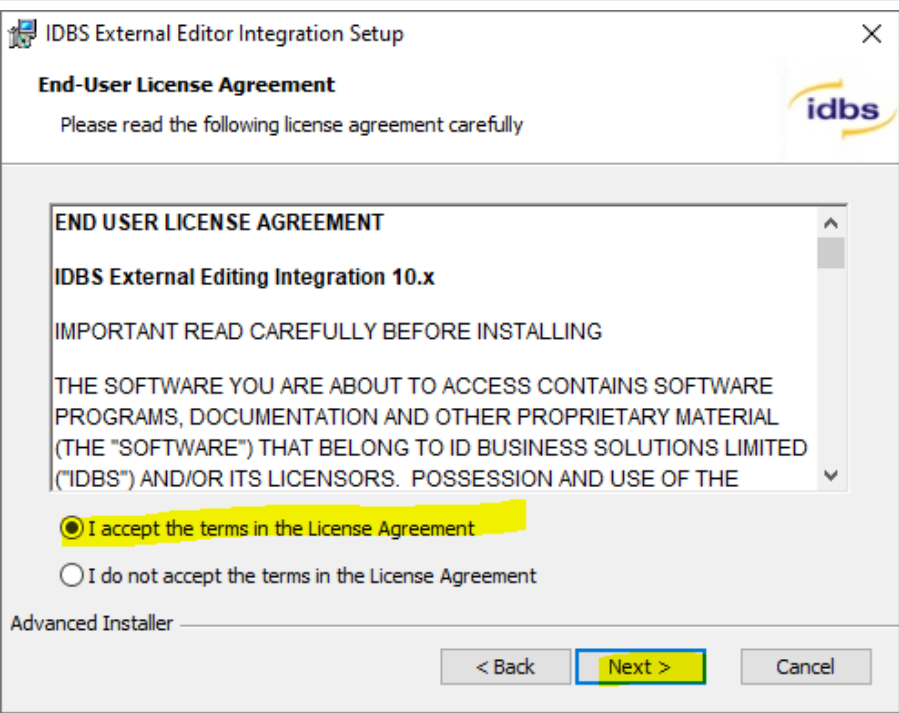
Please find below the installation guide. It doesn't require admin rights so any user can do it by her /himself.

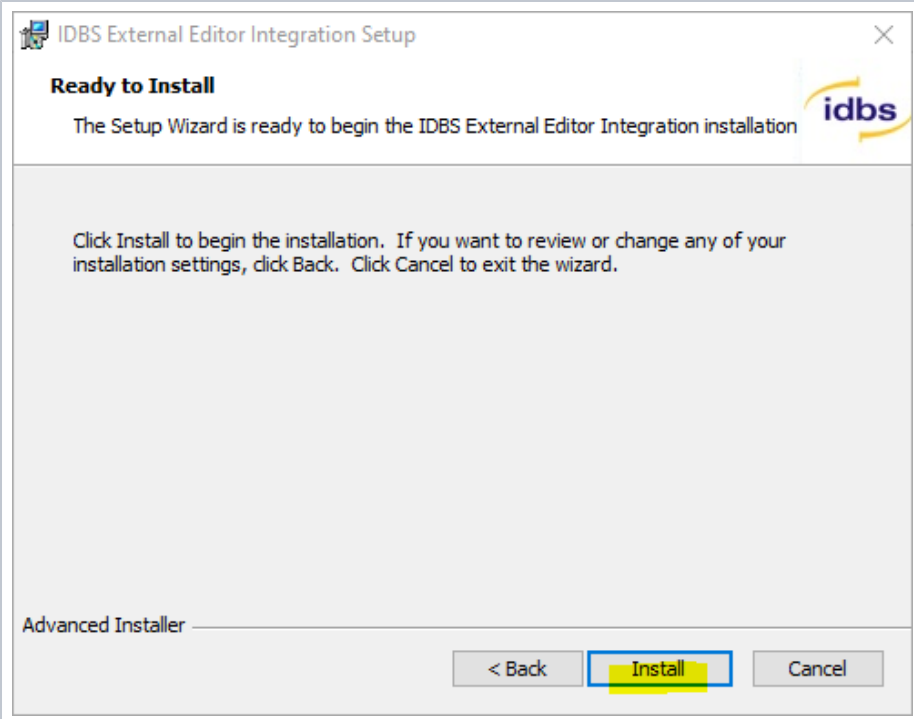
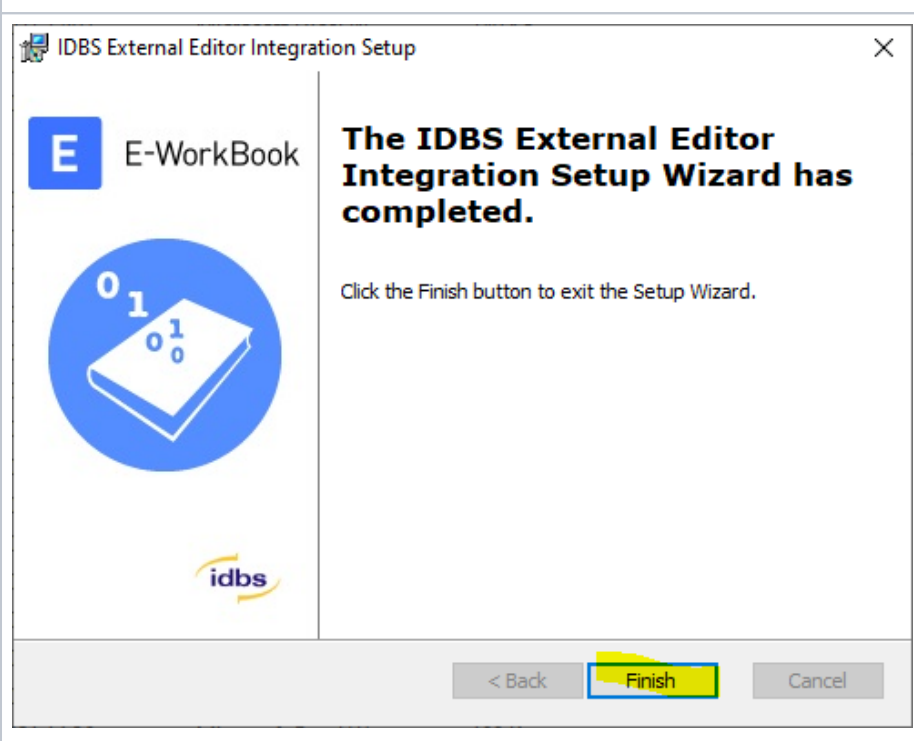
1. Download the source

2. Installation
