<b>1 - GENERAL STATEMENT</b>					
<b>1.4 Roles and responsibilities</b>					
1.4.1	The <b>Plant Manager</b> is responsible to designate a person(s) to implement the requirements specified in this procedure and to ensure adequate resources are available				
1.4.2	The <b>Site</b> shall define and document the roles, responsibilities and qualifications of all people affected by this procedure				
<b>3 - GROUP REQUIREMENTS IN OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH</b>					
<b>3.1 Medical Service Provider</b>					
3.1.1	EXECUTE a service contract with an <b>OH Medical Provider</b>				
3.1.2	For small (< 10 employees) administrative Sites or remote Sites in which an <b>OH Medical Provider</b> is not readily accessible (> 100 miles, 160 km), the <b>Site</b> does not need to have a contract with an OH Medical Provider, provided they HAVE:				
3.1.2.1	ACCESS TO a <b>Medical Service Provider</b> in the vicinity of the Site				
3.1.2.2	COMMUNICATED the potential occupational risks for employees to the <b>Medical Service</b>				

## Health of travellers

As required in the above OH procedure ( [IND-HSE-OH-08-PRO](#), Req.3.2.8), a medical examination is performed prior to any site employee travel to a destination with a high sanitary risk.
