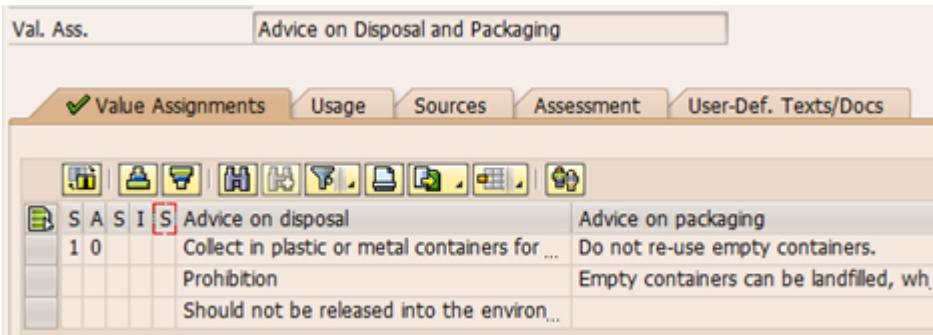


Section 13

- 1 class is used mostly, with 1 characteristic for the advice on disposal of the product and 1 for the advice on the packaging



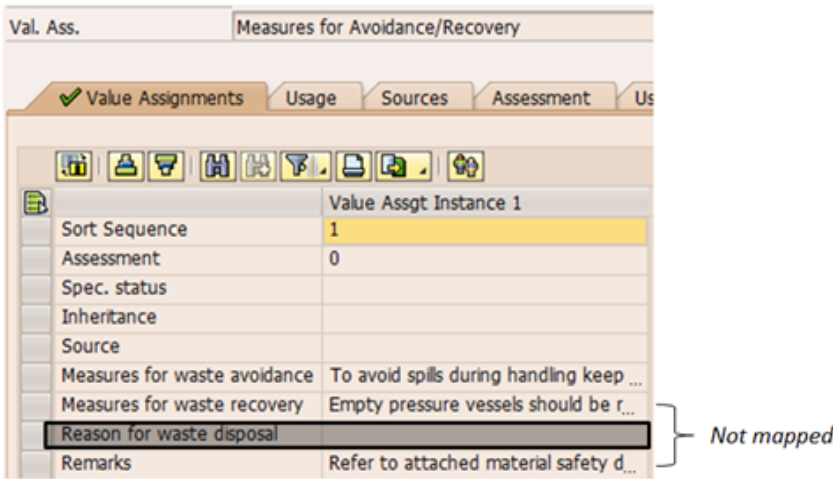
Product Disposal

- Collect in plastic or metal containers for disposal.
- **Prohibition**
- Should not be released into the environment.

Advice on cleaning and disposal of packaging

- Do not re-use empty containers.
- Empty containers can be landfilled, when in accordance with the local regulations.

- Additionally, the class "Measures for waste avoidance/recovery" may be used to indicate how to avoid generating waste, how to recover it and some remarks. No data has been transferred to this class for now and the subtitle will not appear



Measure for waste avoidance or recovery

- To avoid spills during handling keep bottle on a metal tray.
- Empty pressure vessels should be returned to the supplier.
- Refer to attached material safety data sheets for advice for handling and storage of each mixture.
