In case of skin contact

- Cool skin rapidly with cold water after contact with hot polymer.

Exposure to decomposition products

- Wash off with soap and water.
- Immediately apply calcium gluconate gel 2.5% and massage into the affected area using rubber gloves; continue to massage while repeatedly applying gel until 15 minutes after pain is relieved.
- Consult a physician.

- First Aid ingestion
 - If victim is conscious/ unconscious must be maintained as phrases in the general class

In case of ingestion

- Do NOT induce vomiting.
- Do not give anything to drink.
- If victim is conscious:

- If victim is unconscious:
- Call a physician immediately.

- The sections 4.2 and 4.3 are managed inside the class Notes to Physicians
 - You may indicate the route of exposure (optional)
 - Split between Symptoms and Hazards (mapped as Effects) only, according to the ECHA guidance
 - Exposure to decomposition may be used as a subtitle in any characteristic
 - At high concentrations may be used as a subtitle in the characteristic Symptoms (only)
 - Repeated or prolonged exposure may be used as a subtitle in the characteristic Hazards (only)
 - The "Treatment" characteristic will always appear in subsection 4.3 and will not be identified with its route.
