Overview

An "Awesome table" is a way to display a Google spreadsheet with advanced functionalities.

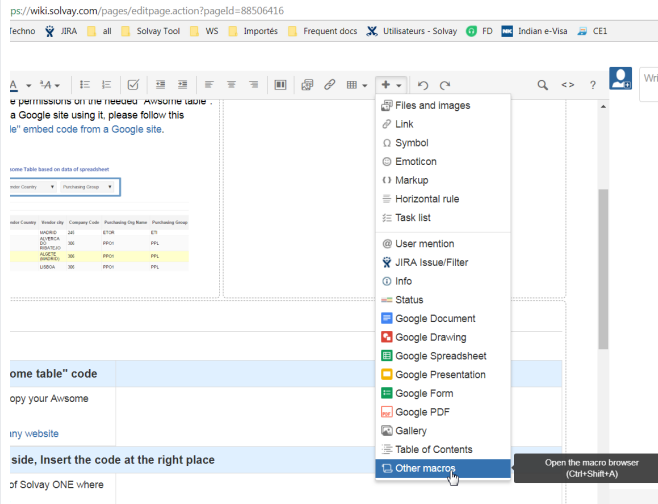

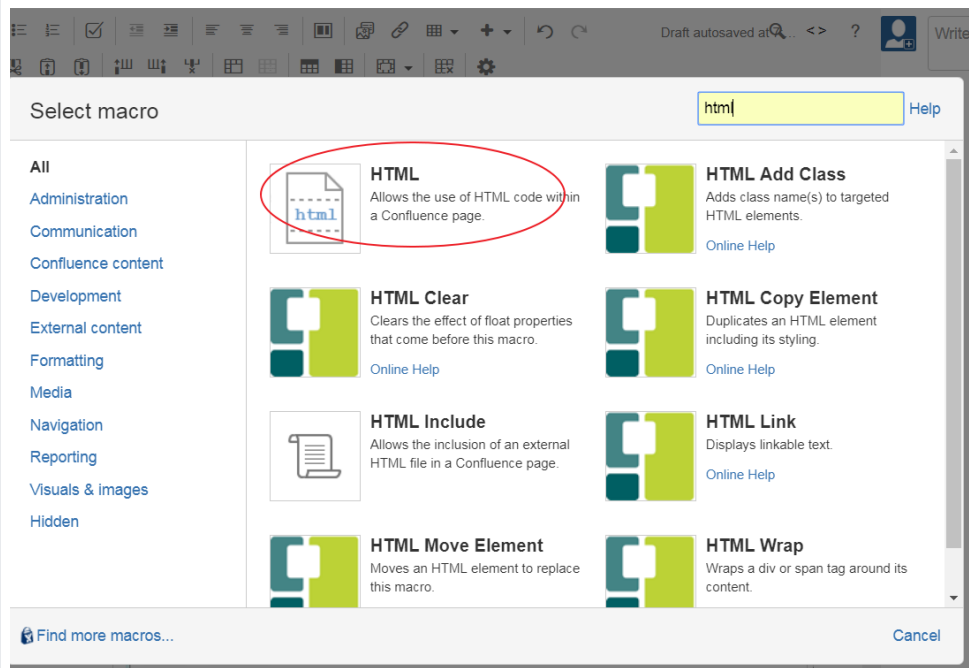
Step-by-step guide

Step 1: Copy the "Awesome table" code	
Use the following guide to copy your Awesome table embed code: Set up Awesome Table on any website	
Step 2: on Confluence side, Insert the code at the right place	
1. open the page you need edit to	

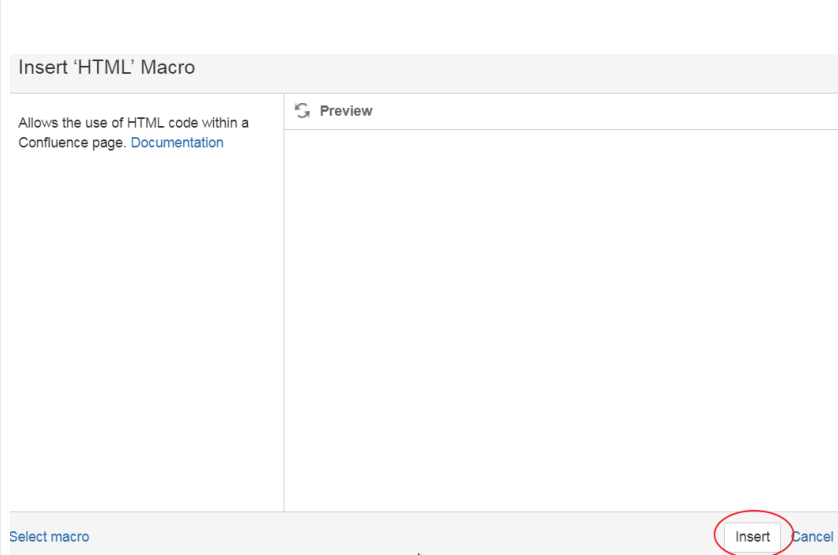
2. click onto "+" symbole then choose "other marcos"



3. search HTML Marco in the list



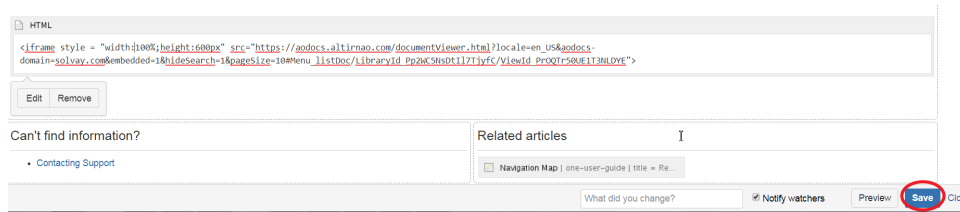
4) inset the Macro



3. Copy the iframe HTML code of the awesome table.
