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### a. Task Scheduler

The Windows Task Scheduler on a server is a tool dedicated to the management of tasks.

Tasks allow to automatically execute programs or scripts (commonly called batches) according to a certain frequency and at predefined times.

### b. Planned Batches

On the backend server where DSCP applications are installed, dedicated tasks and batches are setup in order to trigger some programs.

The execution of batches may :

- directly start
- depend on one (or several) csv file(s) provided by BW. We usually talk about flags :
  1. BW\_DYN\_PART1\_COMPLETE
  2. BW\_DYN\_PART2\_COMPLETE
  3. BW\_MASTER\_COMPLETE
- wait for the end of other batches.
