## General definition :

**Firefighter** IDs. A **firefighter** ID is a temporary user ID that grants the user exception-based, yet regulated, access. The **firefighter** ID is created by a system administrator and assigned to users who need to perform tasks in emergency or extraordinary situations.


## Add an update on WBP :

If you need to have extended accesses in Sap you must use a FireFighter. For that you must be define in the standard table of *users authorized to use a FireFighter*.

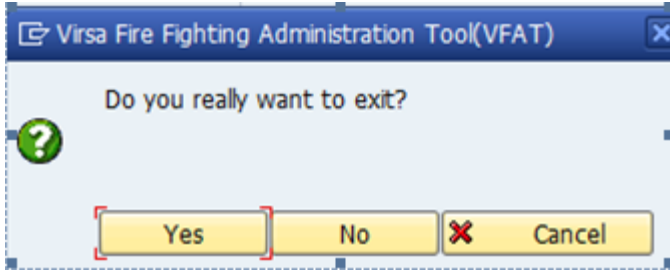
