Business Term Definition

A **cost object** can be used to analyze target costs, actual costs, and variances in situations where costs are not collected at the level of orders or materials.

The **cost object hierarchy** is created by one or more cost object nodes for each level of the hierarchy at which you want to collect actual costs. Applied only to finished or semi-finished goods Manufactured in PF1.
