There are eight goods and services domains - Energy, General Expenses, IT & Telecommunication, Logistics, Packaging, Raw materials, Technical Goods, and Technical services -. "Domain" is the third and last level of the category taxonomy.

It enables category management, in aligning business goals and customer requirements with supply market capability and maximizing long-term value for the organization. This is achieved by using a three-level hierarchy consisting of domain, segment and material group.
