1.4	1.4 Roles and responsibilities				
1.4.1	The Plant Manager is responsible to designate a person(s) to implement the requirements specified in this procedure and to ensure adequate resources are available				
1.4.2	The Site shall define and document the roles, responsibilities and qualifications of all people affected by this procedure				
3 - GROUP REQUIREMENTS IN OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH					
3.1	3.1 Medical Service Provider				
3.1.1	EXECUTE a service contract with an OH Medical Provider				
3.1.2	For small (< 10 employees) administrative Sites or remote Sites in which an OH Medical Provider is not readily accessible (> 100 miles, 160 km), the Site does not need to have a contract with an OH Medical Provider, provided they HAVE:				
3.1.2.1	ACCESS TO a Medical Service Provider in the vicinity of the Site				
3.1.2.2	COMMUNICATED the potential occupational risks for employees to the Medical Service				

Health of travellers

As required in the above OH procedure ([IND-HSE-OH-08-PRO](#), Req.3.2.8), a medical examination is performed prior to any site employee travel to a destination with a high sanitary risk.
