

Multi-Layer Film

Multi-layer film forming is a manufacturing process that **combines two or more different polymers into a single, unified film**, typically through **co-extrusion or lamination**, to achieve enhanced performance characteristics like improved strength, barrier properties, or sealing capabilities that a single-layer film cannot provide. The process can be done in a single step via co-extrusion or by laminating separate films together.
